

## Tournament Rules

### Rules of Play

1. Normal high school rules with stop clock on all dead balls.
  2. There will be (2) 16-minute halves for all divisions.
  3. 4 timeouts total per game – 2 full timeouts and 2 thirty-second timeout.
  4. 3 minute halftime.
  5. Guaranteed 3-minute warm-up between games.
  6. Overtime is 1 minutes – (1) 30-second timeout in overtime with no carryovers. Each extra overtime is sudden death.
  7. **A player fouls out on her 6<sup>th</sup> personal foul.**
  8. A team reaches 1-and-1 bonus on the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul of each half. There is no 2-shot bonus.
  9. Team listed on left and top of bracket is home and wears light color. Bring both colors to game in case a team does not have extra uniforms.
  10. **Home team does clock and away team does book.**
  11. Two technical result in automatic ejection from the game.
  12. **Game time is game time. At game time, clock will start. Once the team arrives, they will be charged a timeout. The opposing team will receive 1 point for every minute the offending team is late, then the game will start from that point(whatever the clock is). Clock will NOT be reset. If team has not arrived by halftime, then it is forfeit.**
  13. Team Trophy will be awarded to (1) Champion and (1) Runner-up per age division.
- A player can ONLY play on one team during the entire event. A player cannot play in two different age groups or the same age group during the tournament. If a team loses, that player cannot switch to another team still in competition. All players participating in bracket play must have participated in at least one of the team's pool games.

14. If a team is ahead by 20 or more points, the clock will not stop during the last minute.
15. The Tournament Director will have the final say regarding any disputes. This tournament is for the kids – let's always keep that in mind.

**\*\*New NCAA guidelines prohibit teams from playing more than 3 games in one day and no more than 5 games in a two day period. We tried to give teams as many games as possible and as much exposure as possible.**
